## 【Notes on Recommendation of Students】

1. As it is required to report to Japan Student Services Organization (JASSO) the student's academic performance in order for him/her to receive the scholarship, please mention in the recommendation form of Program A, C and E the applicant's rank based on his/her overall academic performance in the department which he/she belongs to at your university. Also, if there is more than one student you would like to recommend for a program, please indicate for each of them the order of recommendation priorities by using numbers.
2. If your institution has concluded a memorandum on mutual tuition waiver with Kanazawa University, students of up to the number specified in the memorandum shall have their tuition waived unless other exchange program doesn't use the tuition waiver quota. Regarding tuition in the academic year 2019, please refer to the "The Guidelines for Applicants to Kanazawa University Short-term Exchange Programs".
3. Each student may apply for up to 3 programs. Regarding Program B, only applicants who select it as their first choice will be considered.
4. Please note that some students cannot be accepted when we have more applicants than the maximum number of students to be admitted in a program, and enrollment in the program does not guarantee that the student could receive the scholarship.

## Guidelines for Application for Short-term Exchange Programs at Kanazawa University (2019–2020)

These programs are designed for students enrolled at institutions that have an exchange agreement with Kanazawa University\* who intend to study at Kanazawa University for a period of not less than six months to not more than one year. While remaining enrolled at their home institutions, such students may study in a non-degree program at Kanazawa University for the purposes of experiencing a foreign culture, learning practical Japanese, taking credited classes, or participating in independent research under the guidance of a supervisor.

Immigration to Japan<br/>There are certain formalities that must be observed by international students intending to pursue studies in Japan. Students should possess a valid passport issued by their home country. They are also required to apply at their nearest Japanese diplomatic mission (embassy or consulate) for a “College Student” visa. A College Student visa will only be issued after the diplomatic mission is in possession of the applicant's “Certificate of Eligibility.” However, Japanese government scholarship (MEXT) students undertaking Program B need to obtain a visa by other means. The Student Affairs Division of Kanazawa University shall submit applications for the Certificate of Eligibility to the immigration office at Kanazawa on behalf of exchange students. The Certificate of Eligibility will then be sent to the students. When applying for the visa, students must take the Certificate of Eligibility and their passport to the diplomatic mission. Students should also be sure to bring the Certificate of Eligibility with them and show it to immigration authorities at the airport when they enter Japan.</p> |
